

**THE ELECTRICITY SAFETY, QUALITY and CONTINUITY
REGULATIONS 2002**

CERTIFICATE OF EXEMPTION

1. The Health and Safety Executive, in pursuance of the powers conferred on it by section 33 of the Electricity Safety, Quality and Continuity Regulations 2002 (the "Regulations"), the Health and Safety at Work etc Act 1974 (as amended by the Legislative Reform (Health and Safety Executive) Order 2008), and by the Agreement dated 2 October 2006 between the Secretary of State for Trade and Industry and the Health and Safety Commission, and being satisfied as required by regulation 33(2) hereby grants an exemption to the person or persons installing the source of energy from the requirements imposed by regulation 22(2)(c) of the Regulations subject to the condition set out in paragraph 2 of this certificate.
2. The condition referred to in paragraph 1 of this certificate is that in so far as Regulation 22(2)(c) of the Regulations applies to a source of energy, the person or persons installing the source of energy will ensure that the distributor is advised of the intention to use the source of energy in parallel with the network no later than 28 days (inclusive of the day of commissioning), after commissioning the source.
3. This certificate shall come into force on 4 August 2008 and remain in force until revoked by the Health and Safety Executive by a certificate in writing.
