Responsibilities will include:

- Supporting the gas networks with development, delivery and monitoring of key projects and deliverables
- Providing reporting to the sector's Gas Strategy Group and other groups as required
- Project and meeting administration including management of programme documentation, tracking performance, taking minutes at meetings and tracking delivery of actions

- Logistical support including event planning, workshops and stakeholder meetings
- Inputting into pieces of analysis and research as required
- Liaising with the communications teams at ENA and in the networks to support delivery of communications materials
- Working closely with other teams at ENA and with the wider energy industry to support the development of optimal, whole systems solutions for decarbonisation
- Supporting the wider gas team as required
