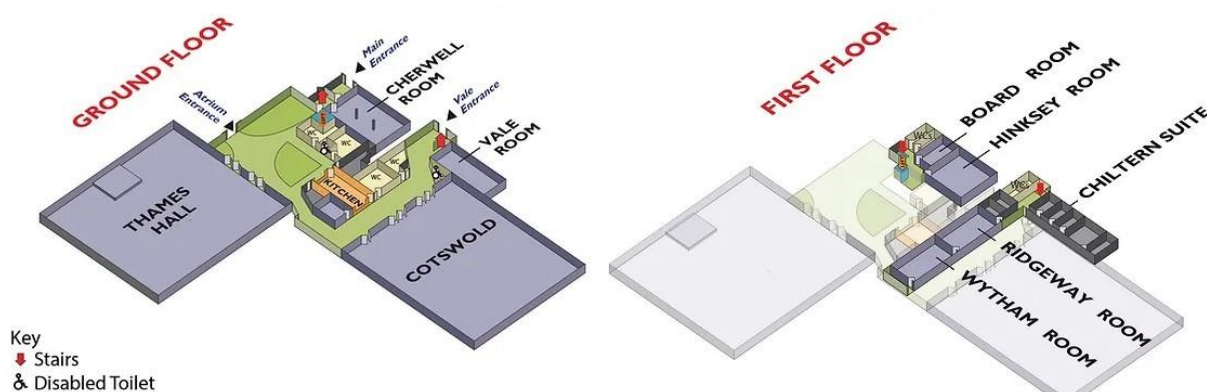
#### Conference venue

#### Wi-Fi

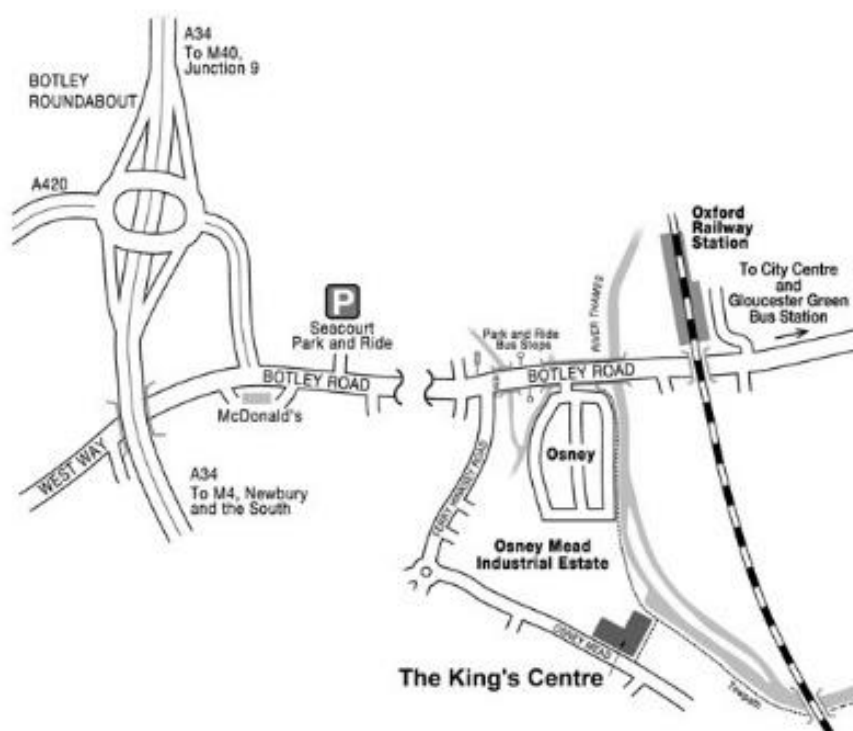
The venue provides free Wi-Fi to all delegates. To connect please log on to the TKCL Premium Internet network and follow the instructions.
