

Open Networks CEM and Tool User Forum: Process for inviting participation

July 2021 Update

To date, the applications we've received don't currently cover the breadth of industry representation that would be required to run this forum successfully. We have therefore decided we will be keeping the User Forum application process open for the foreseeable future. Once the range of applications show a sufficient representation across the industry we will look to initiate a User Forum. All applicants will be kept informed once this stage is reached.

Invitation to Participate

- 1.1 A priority for the project team has been to strengthen our Open Governance approach by developing more collaborative ways to operate and put principles of transparency, participation and accountability into practice. To develop and inform this work on Open Governance this year, the CEM was chosen to be delivered via a User Forum a first for the project which would enable industry representatives to join the product team and participate in its ongoing development
- 1.2 We invite representatives from the areas below to express their interest in joining the WS1A P1 User Forum.
- 1.3 The draft ToR and the sections below provide further details on the requirements and the process that will be followed.
- 1.4 The User Forum will undertake wider engagement through the Open Networks Advisory Group forums and will identify public consultations, requests for information and other mechanisms for wider engagement where required.

Selection process

- 4.1 Our intention is to setup this User Forum with up to 25 non-network industry reps. We are limiting this to ensure that we can keep the User Forum productive.
- 4.2 We will review all the requests to join and will shortlist representatives based on the information submitted. If there are more candidates than places we will select the candidate based on the information submitted, preferring candidates with relevant experience of financial assessment of engineering solutions using CBA modelling and candidates with wide experience offering perspectives on how the CEM and Tool could be developed for assessing engineering solutions.
